



Beable Rostering and Single sign-on Policy

Rostering

Beable’s platform supports different mechanisms for rostering, such as OneRoster (via CSV files or APIs), Classlink, Canvas and Clever.

These mechanisms allow users to import and sync their class rosters from other systems or sources.

Single sign-on

Beable’s platform enables seamless and secure access to our learning resources by supporting various technologies for single sign-on.

These include Azure Active Directory, Canvas, Clever, Classlink, HelloID, OAuth2, and SAML. These technologies allow users to log in with their existing credentials from other platforms or services.

Roster Data and the OneRoster Specification

PII is collected for the purpose of providing students with access to the system, and teachers with the ability to monitor their students’ progress.
